Refund Policy:

Refunds (cost of course less \$5.00) are granted only when the office is notified at least 2 working days prior to the first class of a course. If 2-day notification is not given, transfer to a future course plus \$5.00 transfer fee can be arranged.

For Chapter facilitated Community Learn-to-Swim program, refunds are granted only when the office is provided doctor verification of inability to participate.

Enrollment in Courses:

Pre-payment is required at the time of registration. See course listings for costs. CPR and First Aid classes must have 6 or more participants, maximum is 12 participants. Recertification courses may have up to 16 participants. Courses without the minimum number of participants registered 2 business days before the first class may be cancelled and payment refunded in full or credited to a future course.

Must be 17 years or older and pass pre-course skills and tests. Deadline to enroll in a CPR Instructor course is 4:00 on the Friday one week before the start of the course. Some materials must be picked up prior to the course for self study.
